MidAmerica Technology was approached by Technology Dynamics of Indianapolis to implement a printer consolidation solution for MSD of Mount Vernon School District. The School Corporation is situated in the southwest corner of Posey County, Indiana. The Corporation consists of Marris Elementary, West Elementary, Hedges Special Education Office, Farmersville Elementary, Mount Vernon Junior High School, Mount Vernon High School, Administration Office and Maintenance Facility. These eight buildings serve a school population of approximately 2,200 students. There are 204 certified teachers, 15 administrative personnel, and 210 non-certified support staff.

The Challenge

The MSD of Mount Vernon School District wanted a print consolidation solution that would provide them with a substantial cost savings.

They also required the ability of the faculty to print documents securely and allow them to retrieve their prints on ANY of their networked printers throughout the campus.

Such a solution would need to give them accurate tracking and reporting

by user, department, location, and device to minimize the spend for their printing environment.

One of the next issues was dealing with a variety of local printers from various manufacturers in the school. The majority of these expensive-to-operate printers were in the teacher classrooms. That makes for the total administration and service of the whole print fleet very complicated.
